**Course Description:** This is a live, hands-on training course for preschool instructors and teachers. Course topics include: fundamental movement for children, class safety overview, games, activities to avoid, manipulatives, lesson planning, inclusion of music, thematic teaching, parent/child teaching, and the use of apparatus. This is a great hands-on follow-up to the theory course, with course instructors demonstrating practical examples of many of the concepts taught in R101. It is strongly recommended to complete R101 prior to taking R102 Preschool Fundamentals: Hands-On Training, but this is not a requirement.
